Bare Faced in the Park by John Sutton TOWN PARK- SUMMER DAY

YOUNG MAN

YOUNG MAN

YOUNG MAN

Please can you help me here?

The LADY comes over.

YOUNG MAN

LADY

TOWN PARK - SUMMER DAY

LADY

(pause)

The LADY switches off her mobile and turns to the YOUNG MAN.

LADY

YOUNG MAN

LADY

I don't think they recommend that anymore

YOUNG MAN

Well, I can't just do nothing. She might well be dead by the time they get here.

The YOUNG MAN stoops and begins mouth to mouth. After a few moments the WOMAN stirs and opens her eyes.

WOMAN

Where am I?

LADY

You just lie still. We've sent for the ambulance.

The WOMAN tries to sit up. The YOUNG MAN attempts to restrain her.

WOMAN

I'm alright. In fact I feel bloody marvellous.

SELDON PARK - LATER

It is getting dark. The WOMAN is being lifted into an ambulance. She smiles weakly at the para-medics.

WOMAN

You'll probably call this bare faced cheek

The WOMAN raises her arm and indicates the YOUNG MAN.

WOMAN
